

## 7 Publish

On a computer or a separate sheet of paper, create a neat final draft of your informative/explanatory text.

Correct all errors that you identified while editing your draft. Be sure to give your informative/explanatory text an interesting title.

The final step is to publish your informative/explanatory text. Here are some different ways you might choose to share your work.

- Read your informative/explanatory text aloud to your class or to a small group of your classmates.
- Create a class book or magazine that includes all the texts about the yeti crab, as well as pictures or diagrams.
- Create a poster, using your informative/explanatory text and drawings or photographs from magazines or newspapers.
- Display your informative/explanatory text on the class bulletin board.
