Yellow	<p>Do not shout like that in the library.</p> <p>His sister is learning to count to one hundred.</p> <p>What are the directions again? North, south, east, and west.</p> <p>I enjoying looking at the clouds and imagining what animal it could be.</p> <p>How did he end up in the classroom while we were outside?</p>
