Blue	<p>The soccer ball has lost a lot of air, can you inflate it before we play?</p> <p>The chipmunk will inhabit the interior of the tree during the winter.</p> <p>The birthday balloon has lost some of the helium, it has deflated a bit.</p> <p>I have frozen corn, can you put it in the microwave to defrost it for dinner?</p> <p>You can't deprive me of my electronics for an entire week!</p>
Green	<p>Between the two hills is a valley that can flood if it rains hard enough.</p> <p>Will your family serve ham or turkey for Thanksgiving this year?</p> <p>Who wants to be goalie in the game during recess?</p> <p>Did you hear that eerie sound coming from the abandoned house?</p> <p>I slammed my pinkie finger in the door last night! Now it has turned purple.</p>
Yellow	<p>What was that noise in the other room?</p> <p>To see if you need to water your plants, put your finger in the soil to see if it is dry or moist.</p> <p>What type of oil do you prefer to use when cooking? Olive or vegetable?</p> <p>You need to raise your voice, I can barely hear you!</p>
